

### 150 Faces for 150 Years

As St Mary's College plans its 150<sup>th</sup> birthday celebrations in 2018, it is seeking nominations for people to be included in a very special book featuring images and stories about 150 people who have made significant contributions to the College community during its first 150 years.

The book will tell the story of St Mary's College through its people, highlighting achievements through personal anecdotes relevant to their time and will be published in time to mark the start of anniversary celebrations.

To bring the project to life, St Mary's is seeking assistance from people who have been involved in the College throughout its history.

How can you help?

Although College archives contain a treasure trove of significant stories, input from its valued community is sought to record as yet untold stories from and about the people who have formed the rich and colourful human landscape of St Mary's College over its 150 years.

Nominations have been open for some time and will remain so until June 1, 2017, so there is still time to get in. So if you or someone you know has made their mark on the College, you are encouraged to tell their story.

St Mary's College Principal, Helen Spencer, is excited about this historic record. "The 150 Faces project is a tangible gesture that celebrates the people and stories of St Mary's College through its history," she said.

"We have had a range of fantastic nominations, but there's room for more and we're aware there must be hundreds out amongst the community, so we're welcoming all submissions at this time".

A set of selection criteria, focusing on contributions made in the spirit of Nano Nagle, the young Irish woman who began the order of nuns who founded St Mary's College – the Presentation Sisters – has been written against which nominations will be assessed.
