WHY OUR UNIFORM IS IMPORTANT

At St Mary's College it is important for students to wear the correct uniform, and wear it well and with pride. Wearing the uniform correctly reflects the spirit, unity and image of the College Community.

FORMAL UNIFORM

- Depending on the weather, students may wear either the full winter or full summer uniform throughout the year.
- The blazer must be worn as part of the uniform to and from school, on formal occasions and in the Cathedral and assemblies.
- Skirts and summer dresses must be to the knee or just above the knee.
- Brown school shoes are to be worn.
- The soft shell jacket can be worn at school, only if the student is wearing a jumper, and is still cold, but doesn't wish to wear the blazer so as to reduce its wear and tear.

EXPECTATIONS

- Hair should be a natural colour, off the face and tied back if it grows below the collar.
- Hair accessories include sky blue, chocolate brown or bottle green ribbons and hairbands.
- Fashion hairclips are not permitted.
- Scarves must be sky blue, chocolate brown or bottle green.
- Gloves must be chocolate brown or bottle green.
- Students may wear a watch, a fine chain necklace (under clothing and not visible) and two pairs of small plain metallic studs (max 5mm) or small plain metallic sleeper earrings worn parallel in the ear lobes (no pearls or stones). No other piercings are permitted.
- Minimal makeup and natural-toned or French nail polish is permitted.

SCHOOL BAGS

School bags are regarded as part of the school uniform and only the regulation school or sports bag are permitted. For health and safety reasons, it is recommended that backpacks should be held by both straps on the back, and carrybags should be held at the student's side (not on shoulder). Sports items must be carried in the regulation sports bag. Graffiti is not permitted on bags.

SPORTING TEAM UNIFORMS

In the Junior School, shorts and polo top should be worn for all team sports.

In the Senior School, all sports teams must wear the St Mary's College trackpants, polo top, rugby top and logo socks to events. All sporting teams are required to wear the St Mary's College skorts or shorts with St Mary's College polo top for competitions. Each sport has a distinctive uniform for matches which is registered with SATIS and cannot be changed. The penalty for a student not being in correct uniform is disqualification from the match or event. The College leggings may only be worn during trainings and HPE lessons and are not to be worn to and from the College.

DRAMA

Blacks consisting of long sleeve black T-shirt and long-leg black stretch pants (not available at the Uniform Shop) are compulsory for all Year 9-12 Drama students.

KEEPING WARM

To keep warm, students can wear an undershirt/thermal which is not to be visible under the blouse or polo top. Students can also wear a cardigan and the jumper under the blazer. Please note that the soft shell jacket is not to be worn with the blazer.

The soft shell jacket is a compulsory part of the Kinder-Year 2 uniform. All other year levels may wear the jacket over their sports or formal uniform if weather requires additional wind/rain protection.



IMPORTANT

Naming Items

All items of uniform should be clearly named and checked regularly to ensure the name is not rubbed off.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

- The sports uniform may be worn to school on HPE days, when the student has a Sports Pass, or when advised by the College.
- If a student does not have the full sports uniform, then the full formal uniform must be worn to and from school.
- Trackpants or shorts must be worn to and from school by all Years 3–12 students when the sports uniform is worn.
- Students may wear the College soft shell jacket over the sports uniform.
- SMC leggings may only be worn at training or HPE lessons or games.
- The skort must not be worn to and from school.
- The sky blue bucket hat must be worn when outside in the sun at lunchtime or during outside activities in Terms 1 and 4.





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
