
Laptop enrolment for Year 7 students



We have reviewed our BYOD model for Year 7 2025 and onwards and are pleased to confirm that **Year 7 2025 will have a school-provided device**, a Lenovo 13w Yoga Gen 2. All students will use this primary, dedicated device and do not need to purchase a separate device for school.

The new laptops will be issued to students at the compulsory laptop enrolment sessions, which will run through the mornings of **Tuesday 28 and Wednesday 29 January 2025**, with sessions commencing on the hour from 9.00am to 12.00pm both days. If students miss this enrolment session, they will receive their new laptop in the first week of school.
